



NSBE CP AWFE + STEM Fair Statement



The National Society of Black Engineers Charlotte Professionals (NSBE CP) chapter is excited to announce our upcoming events: the annual "*A Walk For Education*," which will take place throughout the months of February and March 2024, followed by our **STEM Fair on Saturday, March 16th, 2024**. These events are significant endeavors to help fulfill our mission by promoting and advancing STEM (science, technology, engineering, & math) education in our community.

A Walk For Education (AWFE) is a grassroots program in which NSBE members go door-to-door in underserved communities and hand out information on college opportunities, scholarships, SAT/ACT preparation tools, NSBE, and the benefits of majoring in STEM fields. We firmly believe that education is the key to unlocking the potential of underserved youth, and this event is a powerful means to achieve this objective.

Our last AWFE event took place on February 25th 2023, and was a huge success. Despite wet weather, we handed out approximately 200 "grab bags" full of educational resource materials to students and families in West Charlotte. After receiving grab bags, students were invited to our <u>Science, Engineering, and College Fair</u>. The fair was held at the Stratford Richardson YMCA and featured **two robotics teams**, **three HBCUs**, and **three STEM competitions**.

The **STEM Fair** is the highly-anticipated culmination of AWFE. In 2024, our STEM Fair will take place at the Ivory Baker Recreation Center on March 16th. We aim to expand our STEM Fair to include:

- 10 Colleges/Universities
- 3+ STEM Teams (i.e., robotics teams, etc.)
- Health and Fitness Organizations
- Local Organizations and Business

NSBE's mission: To increase the number of culturally responsible black engineers who excel academically, succeed professionally, and positively impact the community.
